 In verse 23, Paul called death a wage and eternal life a gift. Compare and contrast a wage with a gift. How are they similar? How are they different? What is the significance of Paul calling eternal life a gift?

5. If Paul were around today, what would he say enslaves our society? What about the Christian community?

 - 2. Paul seems to indicate (vv.16+18) that slavery is an "either/or" sort of situation. Why is it impossible to be our own master, enslaved neither to sin nor to God?

 On the right side of slavery, why does Paul speak of slavery to "obedience" (v.16), to "righteousness" (vv.18-19), and to "God" (v.22)? How are these ideas related? 6. How might you focus your life on obeying God as a slave of righteousness through prayer, time in the Word, and other disciplines? What role does community play in our journey toward becoming slaves of righteousness?
