4. Why might the Galatians be tempted to rely on the law for their Christian growth after beginning with the Spirit (v.3)?

5. What difference does it make when you base your relationship with God on how well you keep a list of rules, rather than living in light of the truth that God accepts you through faith?

6. How can we tell the difference between religion-driven things and faith-driven things in our lives?
