### Digging Deeper

2. How does Deuteronomy 27:26 (quoted in Gal. 3:10) provide evidence for the argument that a person cannot be righteous through the Law? How does Habakkuk 2:4 (quoted in Gal. 3:11) provide further evidence?
3. Why does seeking to follow the Law for justification bring a curse? What does it mean to be cursed? How does this curse help support Paul's position?

4. Why is it a problem to try to make God accept us by doing what is good, whether through returning to the Jewish Law or through some other means?

### Reflection

5. How does the idea of being “cursed” by relying on the Law challenge your understanding of grace and forgiveness?
6. When you think about “living by faith,” what specific actions or attitudes come to mind? How do these show up in your life?
