John 11:16; 14:1-6; 20:24-29 – Doubting Thomas? Let's Find Out

### **My Story**

1. In what area(s) of your life do you feel you have changed the most over the years (good or bad)? What contributed to the change(s)?

## **Digging Deeper**

2. Read John 11:1-16. How does Thomas' statement (v.16) contrast with Jesus' perspective on returning to Judea, and what does this reveal about Christ's glory in the unfolding events?

3. Read John 14:1-6. Why do you think Thomas asked Jesus, "How can we know the way?" (v.5), and how does Jesus' response in verse 6 address his concerns?

4. Read John 20:24-29. Why do you think Thomas refused to believe the other disciples' testimony about Jesus' resurrection (v.25)? How does Jesus' statement in verse 29 challenge the idea that seeing is necessary for faith?

#### Reflection

5. What are some ways in which God has revealed His glory to you (i.e., Scripture, creation, prayer, etc.)? How has this encouraged and strengthened your faith?

6. What doubts or questions about God or salvation do you struggle with? What have you found helpful in dealing with doubts?

## **Taking the Next Step**

Take time this week to read Psalm 96:1-13. Prayerfully reflect on the ways in which God is glorified in this passage, and how we are encouraged to praise Him. Let this drive you to exult the Lord in your own prayers this week.
